



2023 Summary

The Race Series finished this year with the Doggie Dash and Dawdle on November 5th (Guy Fawkes Day, for those in the know). This race is a lot of fun with some of the dogs taking part not quite sure of the procedure to follow. Due to injury I had to sit out this year's event without my usual rent-a-dog from Animal Humane, whose main annual fund-raiser this is. Joaquin and Kelley Garcia did run and finished together in 40:06.

There were several races in the series during October, falling into four of the different categories in the series. The Sandia Mountain Shadows 5k and the club's own Forever Young 6-miler were short trail events, while the road races were the Duke City Marathon and Half-Marathon and the Great Pumpkin Chase 10k.

There were series entrants in all these races, with the Nickerson family in particular out in strength. Tessa Nickerson was the women's winner in the Sandia Shadows 5k, and Kellie Nickerson was the winner at the Great Pumpkin Chase 10k as well at the Forever Young 6-miler. She also ran the Duke City Half-marathon in 1:39 but since she already has a higher score for a half-marathon her total is not increased by this. Steve Nickerson ran 51:44 in the Great Pumpkin Chase and added 71 points to his total, now at 210, and Todd Nickerson ran a 39:50 pace in the same event to add 93 points to his score. He also ran very a strong race at Forever Young, placing third overall in 42:15. Cliff Matthews and Geoff Tweed both ran the Duke City marathon. Since Cliff was a pace group leader, he was targeting a specific finish time rather than all-out racing, but nonetheless added 52 points as this was his first score at the marathon distance. Geoff ran strong at Forever Young in 45:37 adding 84 points to his total. Also at Forever Young, Gene Kersh finished 8th overall, scoring 82 points. Diana Bibeau and Tony Recker added 61 and 54 respectively.
